Final Selection Criteria Approved by the Sprint Racing Council – February 5, 2019

Revised – June 17, 2019

INTRODUCTION

1. General

These criteria supplements are subject to the principles and procedures as outlined in the National Team Selection Procedures 2019 - Sprint Document found on the [CKC Website](#).

2. Performance Objectives

The following 2019 Olympic/Paralympic Test Event Team Criteria selection criteria are guided by CKC's performance objectives where a crew demonstrates the ability/potential to make a Top 8 finish in an Olympic/Paralympic event at the competition for which they are being considered. The Olympic/Paralympic Test Event Selection Criteria has prioritized those athletes / crews who have achieved Olympic/Paralympic Qualification criteria at the 2019 Senior World Championships.

3. Selection Procedures

3.1 The Olympic/Paralympic Test Event Regatta will take place on the Olympic/Paralympic Venue in Tokyo September 13-15, 2019.

3.2 Only single and tandem events will be held at the Olympic/Paralympic Test Event.

3.3 Eligibility

3.3.1 Only those athletes who are selected to the 2019 Senior World Championships Team are eligible. See the Senior World Championship Team Selection Criteria Supplement



for details on the requirements for nomination to the 2019 Senior World Championship Team.

3.3.2 NEW: Canada has been assigned quotas for this event (Based on the performance of each discipline at the 2018 World Championships) as follows:

- 3.3.2.1 Men Kayak (1) quota
- 3.3.2.2 Women Kayak (3) quotas
- 3.3.2.3 Men Canoe (3) quotas
- 3.3.2.4 Women Canoe (3) quotas
- 3.3.2.5 Para Canoe (3) quotas

This may mean that CKC will need to decide which athletes from the Senior World Team will be selected.

3.4 Athletes will be selected as follows:

3.4.1 The CTO in consultation with the HC and the NDC will assess athletes using, but not limited to the following factors:

- 3.4.1.1 Global Qualifiers – 2019 Senior World Championships
- 3.4.1.2 Results at the 2019 Senior World Championships
- 3.4.1.3 Results at the 2019 World Cups
- 3.4.1.4 Results at NTTI

The intent of this performance review is to identify athletes according to the quota limits who are most likely to compete for Canada at 2020 Tokyo Olympic/Paralympic Games.
