



NON-OLYMPIC EVENT WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP CRITERIA SUPPLEMENT 2020

Under Review as of April 6, 2020.

Final Selection Criteria Approved by the Sprint Racing Council – February 19, 2020

1. General

These criteria supplements are subject to the principles and procedures as outlined in the National Team Selection Procedures 2020 - Sprint Document found on the [CKC Website](#).

The Non-Olympic Event World Championships will take place in Szeged, Hungary July 10-12, 2020.

2. Performance Objectives

The following 2020 Senior National Team Criteria are guided by CKC's performance objectives where, an athlete/crew demonstrates the ability/potential to a Top 8 finish in an event at the International Competition for which they are being considered.

3. Selection Overview

3.1 **Note: This is a self-pay initiative.**

3.2 The 2020 competition that will be used in the selection of the Team are:

3.2.1 National Team Trials, Montreal, Quebec, June 26-28

3.3 The Non-Olympic Event World Championships Selection Process will be completed by June 30, 2020.

3.4 Athletes selected to the following Teams will not be eligible for nomination:

3.4.1 2020 Junior World Championship Team

3.4.2 2020 U23 World Championship Team

4. Specific Selection Criteria

4.1 NTT (K1/C1)

- 4.1.1 Athletes must race singles at NTT in order to be considered for a nomination.
- 4.1.2 Singles will be open (combined Senior and Junior).
- 4.1.3 Athletes being considered for a nomination in the relevant C1/K1 and C2/K2 events must qualify for the A Final at NTT.
- 4.1.4 Athletes being considered for C2/K2 nomination must finish ahead of all Junior Crews at NTT.
- 4.1.5 Selection will be based on results in the Olympic events at NTT.
- 4.1.6 The following athletes subject to 4.2.3 and 4.2.4 above will be nominated:
 - 4.1.6.1 The two highest ranked athletes in the Men C1 1000
 - 4.1.6.2 The highest ranked Men C2 1000
 - 4.1.6.3 The two highest ranked athletes in the Women C1 200
 - 4.1.6.4 The highest ranked Women C2 500
 - 4.1.6.6 The two highest ranked athletes in the Men K1 1000
 - 4.1.6.7 The highest ranked Men K2 1000
 - 4.1.6.8 The two highest ranked athletes in the Men K1 200
 - 4.1.6.9 The two highest ranked athletes in the Women K1 500
 - 4.1.6.10 The highest ranked Women K2 500
 - 4.1.6.11 The two highest ranked athletes in the Women K1 200
- 4.1.7 Additional athletes / crews may be recommended to the HPC for nomination if the CTO/Head Coach and the NDC determine that the athlete or crew demonstrates the potential to achieve a Top 8 performance at the 2020 Non-Olympic Event World Championships.

4.1.7.1 Factors assessing the quality of performance can include:

- % time differential from the GMT - An athlete/crew's performance against a Gold Medal Time (see Appendix A)
- % time differential from the AFT - An athlete/crew's performance against an A-Final Time (see Appendix A)
- % time differential from the winner of the A Final
- % time differential from the previous finisher
- There will be a combined senior and junior A, B, as well as a Junior and Olympic Hopes Final at NTT.
- Athletes will be ranked according to the position of finish in each of the singles Finals above according to the points formula in Appendix B.
- Unforeseen Circumstances (Section 8 of the National Team Selection Procedures 2020 - Sprint)

These factors are in no particular order and one or more may be used to either support or dismiss a selection. Other factors not listed may also be considered.
