

# U23 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP CRITERIA SUPPLEMENT 2020

#### Under Review as of April 6, 2020.

Final Selection Criteria Approved by the Sprint Racing Council – February 19, 2020; Amended March 2, 2020

#### 1. General

These criteria supplements are subject to the principles and procedures as outlined in the National Team Selection Procedures 2020 - Sprint Document found on the <a href="CKC Website">CKC Website</a>.

The U23 World Championships will take place in Brandenburg, Germany July 16-19, 2020.


## 2. Performance Objectives

The following 2020 Senior National Team Criteria are guided by CKC's performance objectives where, an athlete/crew demonstrates the ability/potential to make a Top 8 finish in an Olympic event at the International Competition for which they are being considered.

#### 3. Selection Overview

- 3.1 Athletes / Crews who are vying for a nomination to the U23 World Championship Team will do so as part of the Olympic Team Selection process.
- 3.2 To be eligible the last year that a competitor can compete in the U23 category is the year that their 23<sup>rd</sup> birthday falls in. (i.e. born on or after January 1<sup>st</sup>, 1997)
- 3.3 The 2020 competitions that will be used in the selection of the Team are:
  - 3.3.1 Olympic Team Trials (OTT), Lake Lanier, Georgia, April 16-19
  - 3.3.2 World Cup #2, Duisburg, Germany, May 30-June 2

- 3.3.3 National Team Trials, Montreal, Quebec, June 26-28
- 3.4 Athletes selected to the following Teams will not be eligible for nomination:
  - 3.4.1 2020 Junior World Championship Team
  - 3.4.2 2020 Olympic Team
- 3.5 The U23 World Championships Selection Process will be completed by June 30, 2020.
- 3.6 To assist crews and coaches, an overview of the selection process is provided below. This chart is an outline of the various paths toward nomination to the Team. The chart is only a guideline and one should review thoroughly the criteria that follow:



## 4. Specific Selection Criteria

- 4.1 OTT (K1/C1, K2/C2)
  - 4.1.1 An athlete/crew can earn a nomination to the 2020 U23 World Team at Olympic Team Trials (OTT) through the following methods:
    - 4.1.1.1 A top 3 finish in Final 1 in the open K1 or C1 Olympic events

- 4.1.1.2 A top 2 finish in Final 1 in open K2/C2 events (Crew must be eligible in its entirety).
- 4.1.2 Eligible U20 Athletes nominated to the U23 World Team at OTT will also be nominated to compete at the 2020 Pan Am Championships. Please see the Pan American Canoe Championship Selection Criteria Supplement for details.
- 4.2 NTT (K1/C1, K2/C2, K4)
  - 4.2.1 All athletes must race singles at NTT (Includes athletes racing in the events that earned them a nomination through 4.1 above).
  - 4.2.2 Singles and K2/C2/K4 will be open (combined Senior and Junior)
  - 4.2.3 In the following events the athlete with the highest position of finish in the A Final will be nominated. To be nominated the athlete must also finish ahead of all Junior athletes.
    Excluded will be those events where a nomination at OTT was achieved:
    - 4.2.3.1 Men's K1 1000m
    - 4.2.3.2 Men's K-1 200
    - 4.2.3.3 Women's K-1500
    - 4.2.3.4 Women's K-1200
    - 4.2.3.5 Women's C-1200
    - 4.2.3.6 Men's C-11000
  - 4.2.4 K2/C2/K4 crews being considered for nomination must:
    - 4.2.4.1 Win K2/C2 or K4 at NTT (Crews must be U23 eligible in their entirety) and;
    - 4.2.4.2 Be subject to a Performance assessment as described below in 4.2.5 below.

- 4.2.5 Additional athletes / crews may be recommended to the HPC for nomination if the CTO/Head Coach and the NDC determine that the athlete or crew demonstrates the potential to achieve a Top 8 performance at the 2020 U23 World Championships.
  - 4.2.5.1 Factors assessing the quality of performance can include:
    - % time differential from the GMT An athlete/crew's performance against a Gold Medal Time (see Appendix A)
    - % time differential from the AFT An athlete/crew's performance against an
       A-Final Time (see Appendix A)
    - % time differential from the winner of the A Final
    - % time differential from the previous finisher
    - There will be a combined senior and junior A, B, as well as a Junior and Olympic Hopes Final at NTT.
    - Athletes will be ranked according to the position of finish in each of the singles Finals above according to the points formula in Appendix B.
    - Unforeseen Circumstances (Section 8 of the National Team Selection Procedures 2020 - Sprint)

These factors are in no particular order and one or more may be used to either support or dismiss a selection. Other factors not listed may also be considered.

## **APPENDIX A**

## **Performance Times**

Any performance times to be compared against the A-Final Time (AFT) will be rounded to the 10<sup>th</sup> of a second E.g. 3.49.46 becomes 3.49.5 or alternatively 38.74 becomes 38.7.
