



AMENDMENT TO PART 2, SECTION 3.3 OF THE CKC-SRD TOKYO 2020 OLYMPIC TEAM CRITERIA SUPPLEMENT

Final version – March 4, 2021

1. Summary

This amendment is specific to the Men's K4 500m selection process. CKC proposes that the Men's K4 500m selection process needs to be amended because the K4 500m crew that satisfied ICF Olympic Qualification Criteria at the 2019 Senior World Championships will be unable to compete at Olympic Team Trials (OTT), March 11-14 due to an injury to one of the crew members. All relevant medical documentation has been reviewed and based on this information it is the recommendation of the CTO and the NDC that alternative racing in this event be considered for selection to the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Team, as is permitted by Section G of the CKC-SRD Tokyo 2020 Olympic Team Criteria Supplement (INP). As such CKC-SRD is proposing an amendment to Part 2, Section 3.3 of the INP as follows:

2. Existing Criteria

- 3.3 Nomination process based on Athlete Quotas achieved at the Global Qualifier -2019 Canoe Sprint World Championships(non-podium).
 - 3.3.1 CKC-SRD earned quota spots in the following events at the 2019 Canoe Sprint World Championships:
 - 3.3.1.1 Women's C1 200m (1 quota)
 - 3.3.1.2 Women's K4 500m (4 quotas)
 - 3.3.1.3 Men's K4 500m (4 quotas)
 - 3.3.2 If the same crew wins Final 1 and Final 2 at OTT, they will be nominated to the COC for inclusion on the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Team.
 - 3.3.3 If the crew that wins Final 1 at OTT does not win Final 2 then a race-off will be held between the winner of Final 1 and the winner of Final 2.
 - 3.3.3.1 The winner of this race-off will be nominated to the COC for inclusion on the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Team.

3. Amendment

CKC-SRD proposes the following amendment:

- 3.3.1 Only the two crews that were constituted at the discretion of the NDC and that were approved by the CTO in accordance with Section B.5 (Part 2) for OTT at the National Team

Olympic Preparation Camp will be included in the process outlined below. No other crews will be included in the process.”

- 3.3.2 If the same crew achieves the highest position of finish at World Cup #1 and wins a “Final”, which shall be held on a date and location to be determined by the CTO in consultation with the HC and the NDC, they will be nominated to the COC for inclusion on the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Team.
- 3.3.3 If the crew that achieves the highest position of finish at World Cup #1 does not win the “Final” that is scheduled as indicated above, then a race off will be conducted at a location and on a date to be determined by the CTO in consultation with the HC and the NDC.
 - 3.3.3.1 The winner of this race-off will be nominated to the COC for inclusion on the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Team.
- 3.3.4 If World Cup #1 is cancelled the following criteria will apply:
 - 3.3.4.1 If the same crew wins Final 1 and Final 2 at a location and on dates to be determined by the CTO in consultation with the HC and the NDC, they will be nominated to the COC for inclusion on the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Team.
 - 3.3.4.2 If the crew that wins Final 1 does not win Final 2 then a race-off will be conducted at a location and on a date to be determined by the CTO in consultation with the HC and the NDC. The race-off will include the winner of Final 1 and the winner of Final 2.
 - 3.3.4.2.1 The winner of this race-off will be nominated to the COC for inclusion on the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Team.
