



2021 JUNIOR TEAM CRITERIA SUPPLEMENT

Amended Version – June 20, 2021

CKC-SRD will follow the evolution of the coronavirus (COVID-19) and how it may impact the 2021 Junior Team Criteria Supplement. CKC-SRD reserves the right to modify these criteria based on the best available information. Any modifications will be made promptly and will be communicated to all affected individuals as soon as possible.

The International Canoe Federation recently made the following changes to the 2024 Olympic Program: Removal of the K1 200 men and women and a change in distance for the Men K2 and C2 1000 to 500 meters. This selection criteria supplement has been amended to reflect the new 2024 Olympic Program.

Due to the recent Coronavirus news across the country the National Team Trials have been postponed to August as part of the National Championships, August 23-29, 2021. As such this document has been updated accordingly. Due to the Covid-19 restrictions for hosting the National Championships, selection will be based on separate U18, U17 & U16 races.

1. General

- 1.1. This criteria supplement is subject to the principles and procedures as outlined in the National Team Selection Procedures 2021 - Sprint Document found on the [CKC Website](#).
- 1.2. The 2021 competitions for which Canoe Kayak Canada will identify junior eligible crews are listed below:
 - 1.2.1 2021 ICF Junior Sprint World Championships – Montemor-O-Velho, Portugal, September 3-6, 2021
 - 1.2.2 Olympic Hopes International Regatta, - Racice, Czech Republic, September 10-12, 2021
- 1.3 Athletes who are nominated to the Junior World Championship Team will not be eligible to be nominated to the U23 World Championship Team.
- 1.4 Eligible athletes who are nominated to the Junior World Championship Team will also be nominated to the Olympic Hopes Team.
- 1.5 An athlete who is nominated to the Junior World Team must either accept or decline the nomination to the Olympic Hopes Team. If they accept the Olympic Hopes nomination, they will be responsible for both participation fees as outlined in section 1.6 below.
- 1.6 Participation Fees

1.6.1	Junior World Championships	\$1000
1.6.2	Olympic Hopes	\$2500

2. Performance Objectives

The following 2021 Junior National Team Criteria are guided by CKC's performance objectives where, a crew demonstrates the ability/potential to make a Top 8 finish in an Olympic event at the International Competition for which they are being considered. The Junior National Team is considered an important steppingstone on the pathway to the podium at Senior World Championships and Olympic Games.

3. Selection Overview

3.1. Eligibility

- 3.1.1. All athletes must have reached the age of 15 in 2021 (Born on or before December 31st, 2006).
- 3.1.2. Junior World Championship athletes must be 18 years of age or younger (Born on or after January 1st, 2003).
- 3.1.3. Olympic Hopes U17 athletes must be 17 years of age or younger (Born on or after January 1st, 2004).
- 3.1.4. Olympic Hopes U16 athletes must be 16 years of age or younger (Born on or after January 1st, 2005).
- 3.1.5. All crews being considered for Junior World Championship Team must be junior eligible in their entirety.

3.2 Final nominations to the Team will occur on or before:

- 3.2.1 Junior World Championship Team - August 26, 2021
- 3.2.2 Olympic Hopes International Regatta - August 30, 2021

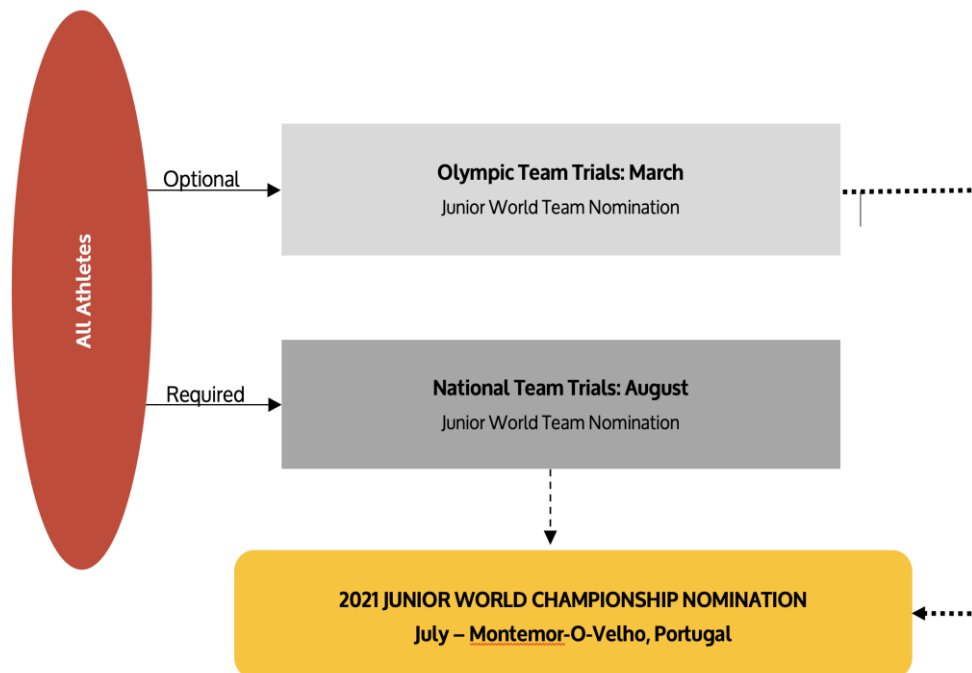
3.3 All entries for 2021 Junior National Team competitions must be approved by the HC.

3.4 Selection Trials

- 3.4.1 The following competitions will be used as Selection Trials for nomination to the Junior Team:
 - Olympic Team Trials (OTT), Burnaby, March 11-14, 2021 (Not Required)
 - Possible Nomination to Junior Worlds & Olympic Hopes
 - National Championships, August 23-29, 2021 (Required)
 - Possible Nomination to Junior Worlds & Olympic Hopes

4. Specific Selection Criteria - Junior World Championships

- 4.1 To assist crews and coaches, an overview of the selection process is provided below. This chart is an outline of the various paths toward nomination to the Team. The chart is only a guideline, and one should review thoroughly the criteria that follows:



4.2 OTT (K1/C1, K2/C2)

4.2.1 A crew can earn a nomination to the 2021 Junior World Team at Olympic Team Trials (OTT) through the following methods:

4.2.1.1 A nomination to the Continental Olympic Qualification Team

Note: It is not required to race at OTT to earn a nomination to the 2021 Junior World Championship Team.

4.3 National Championships (K1/C1)

Please note that due to the ongoing Coronavirus restrictions and the varying ability within Provinces to hold K2/K4/C2 crew training, it is the decision of CKC-SRD to remove C2, K2 and K4 events from the selection process for Junior World Championships at National Championships, August 23-29, 2021.

4.3.1 All athletes must race Paris 2024 Olympic singles at the National Championships (Includes athletes racing in the events that earned them a nomination through 4.2 above).

4.3.2 There will be a separate U18 age category at the National Championships.

4.3.3 Crews will be selected based on the position of finish in each of the singles finals as follows:

4.3.3.1 Men's Kayak (5 athletes)

4.3.3.1.1 Men's K1 1000m (1st and 2nd place crews)

4.3.3.1.2 Men's K1 500 (1st and 2nd place crews)

4.3.3.1.3 Men's K1 200 (1st place crew only)

- 4.3.3.2 Women's Kayak (5 athletes)
 - 4.3.3.2.1 Women's K1 500 (1st, 2nd and 3rd place crews)
 - 4.3.3.2.2 Women's K1 200 (1st and 2nd place crews)
- 4.3.3.3 Women's Canoe (4 athletes)
 - 4.3.3.3.1 Women's C1 200 (1st and 2nd place crews)
 - 4.3.3.3.2 Women's C1 500 (1st and 2nd place crews)
- 4.3.3.4 Men's Canoe (4 athletes)
 - 4.3.3.4.1 Men's C1 1000 (1st and 2nd place crews)
 - 4.3.3.4.2 Men's C1 500 (1st and 2nd place crews)

4.3.4 In the event that the same crew achieves the required position of finish above in more than one event, crews will be nominated from a ranking list as follows:

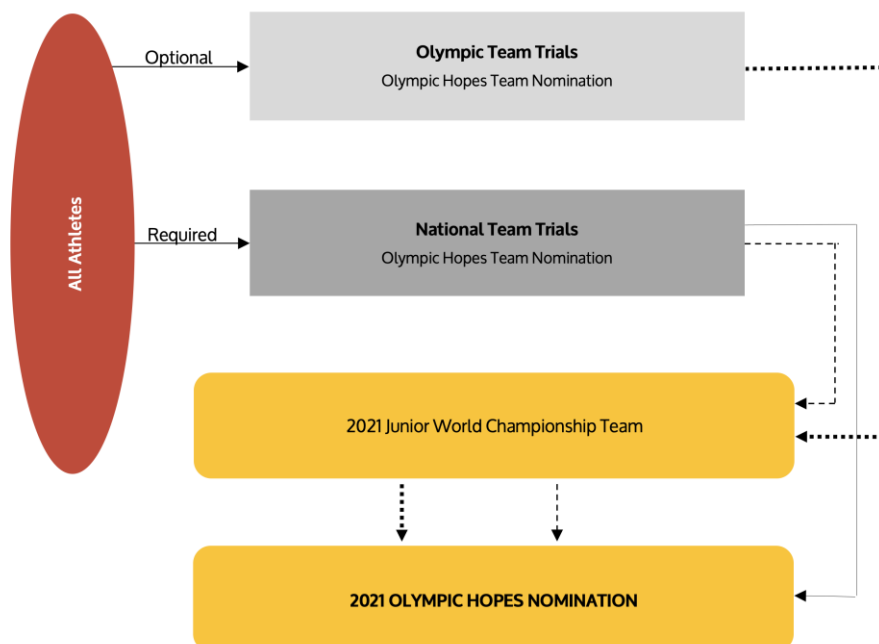
- 4.3.4.1 Men's Kayak
 - 4.3.4.1.1 1000/500 Ranking List
 - 4.3.4.1.2 In the case of a tie the crew with the highest position of finish in the 1000m event will be nominated.
- 4.3.4.2 Women's Kayak
 - 4.3.4.2.1 A 500/200 Ranking List
 - 4.3.4.2.2 In the case of a tie the crew with the highest position of finish in the 500m event will be nominated.
- 4.3.4.3 Women's Canoe
 - 4.3.4.3.1 A 500/200 Ranking List
 - 4.3.4.3.2 In the case of a tie the crew with the highest position of finish in the 200m event will be nominated.
- 4.3.4.4 Men's Canoe
 - 4.3.4.4.1 A 1000/500 Ranking List.
 - 4.3.4.4.2 In the case of a tie the crew with the highest position of finish in the 1000m event will be nominated.

4.4 Entries at the Junior World Championships

4.4.1 All entries will be recommended by the NDC and approved by the HC.

5. Specific Selection Criteria - Olympic Hopes

- 5.1 To assist athletes/crews and coaches, an overview of the selection process is provided below. This chart is an outline of the various paths toward nomination to the Team. The chart is only a guideline, and one should review thoroughly the criteria that follows:



- 5.2 OTT
- 5.2.1 An athlete/crew can earn a nomination to the Olympic Hopes Team at Olympic Team Trials (OTT) through the following methods:
- 5.2.2 A nomination to the Continental Olympic Qualification Team
- Note: It is not required to race at OTT to earn a nomination to the 2021 Olympics Hopes Team.**
- 5.3 National Championships (K1/C1)
- 5.3.1 All athletes must race Paris 2024 Olympic singles at the National Championships (Includes athletes racing in the events that earned them a nomination through 5.2 above).
- 5.3.2 There will be separate U17 and U16 races at the National Championships
- 5.4 Eligible crews nominated to the Junior World Championship Team through the U18 selection process will also be nominated to the Olympic Hopes Team. If they accept the nomination and agree to be responsible for the applicable participation fee, then they will be allocated the events that earned them the nomination to the Junior World Team as identified below in 5.4 and 5.5.
- 5.5 **U17 crews** will be nominated based on the position of finish in each of the U17 single finals as follows
- 5.5.1 Men's Kayak (5 athletes)
- 5.5.1.1 Men's K1 1000m (1st and 2nd place crews)
- 5.5.1.2 Men's K1 500 (1st and 2nd place crews)

- 5.5.1.3 Men's K1 200 (1st place crew only)
- 5.5.2 Women's Kayak (5 athletes)
 - 5.5.2.1 Women's K1 500 (1st, 2nd and 3rd place crews)
 - 5.5.2.2 Women's K1 200 (1st and 2nd place crews)
- 5.5.3 Women's Canoe (4 athletes)
 - 5.5.3.1 Women's C1 200 (1st and 2nd place crews)
 - 5.5.3.2 Women's C1 500 (1st and 2nd place crews)
- 5.5.4 Men's Canoe (4 athletes)
 - 5.5.4.1 Men's C1 1000 (1st and 2nd place crews)
 - 5.5.4.2 Men's C1 500 (1st and 2nd place crews)
- 5.5.5 If the same crew achieves the required position of finish above in more than one event, crews will be nominated from a ranking list as follows:
 - 5.5.5.1 Men's Kayak
 - 5.5.5.1.1 1000/500 Ranking List
 - 5.5.5.1.2 In the case of a tie the crew with the highest position of finish in the 1000m event will be nominated.
 - 5.5.5.2 Women's Kayak
 - 5.5.5.2.1 A 500/200 Ranking List
 - 5.5.5.2.2 In the case of a tie the crew with the highest position of finish in the 500m event will be nominated.
 - 5.5.5.3 Women's Canoe
 - 5.5.5.3.1 A 500/200 Ranking List
 - 5.5.5.3.2 In the case of a tie the crew with the highest position of finish in the 200m event will be nominated.
 - 5.5.5.4 Men's Canoe
 - 5.5.5.4.1 A 1000/500 Ranking List.
 - 5.5.5.4.2 In the case of a tie the crew with the highest position of finish in the 1000m event will be nominated.
- 5.6 **U16 crews** will be nominated according to the following criteria:
 - 5.6.1 Crews will be selected based on the position of finish in each of the U16 single finals as follows:
 - 5.6.1.1 Men's Kayak (5 athletes)
 - 5.6.1.1.1 Men's K1 1000m (1st and 2nd place crews)
 - 5.6.1.1.2 Men's K1 500 (1st and 2nd place crews)
 - 5.6.1.1.3 Men's K1 200 (1st place crew only)
 - 5.6.1.2 Women's Kayak (5 athletes)
 - 5.6.1.2.1 Women's K1 500 (1st, 2nd and 3rd place crews)
 - 5.6.1.2.2 Women's K1 200 (1st and 2nd place crews)
 - 5.6.1.3 Women's Canoe (4 athletes)
 - 5.6.1.3.1 Women's C1 200 (1st and 2nd place crews)
 - 5.6.1.3.2 Women's C1 500 (1st and 2nd place crews)

- 5.6.1.4 Men's Canoe (4 athletes)
 - 5.6.1.4.1 Men's C1 1000 (1st and 2nd place crews)
 - 5.6.1.4.2 Men's C1 500 (1st and 2nd place crews)

5.6.2 In the event that the same crew achieves the required position of finish above in more than one event, crews will be nominated from a ranking list as follows:

- 5.6.2.1 Men's Kayak
 - 5.6.2.1.1 1000/500 Ranking List
 - 5.6.2.1.2 In the case of a tie the crew with the highest position of finish in the 1000m event will be nominated.
- 5.6.2.2 Women's Kayak
 - 5.6.2.2.1 A 500/200 Ranking List
 - 5.6.2.2.2 In the case of a tie the crew with the highest position of finish in the 500m event will be nominated.
- 5.6.2.3 Women's Canoe
 - 5.6.2.3.1 A 500/200 Ranking List
 - 5.6.2.3.2 In the case of a tie the crew with the highest position of finish in the 200m event will be nominated.
- 5.6.2.4 Men's Canoe
 - 5.6.2.4.1 A 1000/500 Ranking List.
 - 5.6.2.4.2 In the case of a tie the crew with the highest position of finish in the 1000m event will be nominated.

5.7 Entries at the Olympic Hopes Regatta

All entries will be recommended by the NDC and approved by the HC.
