Canoe Kayak Canada Waiver for Strapping Within Boats

INTRODUCTION

This Canoe Kayak Canada Waiver for Strapping Within Boats (the “**Waiver**”) applies to [_____] (herein after referred to as the “**Competition**”) and must be completed by any athlete who uses strapping in their boats prior to the athlete participating in the Competition. For the avoidance of doubt, signature of this Waiver is a condition of the athlete’s participation at the Competition and failure to respect this condition will result in the athlete’s participation in the Competition being refused by CKC or any other organization that has authority over the Competition.

AGREEMENT AND WAIVER

1. By signing this Waiver, I understand and agree that any strapping used within my boat must be quick release. However, if I am unable to use quick release strapping for a justifiable reason, I must demonstrate that I am safely able to escape if my boat capsizes.
2. I represent that I am able to quickly and easily release myself from any strapping that holds me in place in my boat, and that I am able to do so should my boat capsize at any time while I am on the water.
3. I agree that CKC and its coaches, trainers, instructors, agents, staff, volunteers, directors, sponsors, consultants, partners and representatives (collectively referred to as the “**Organization**”), as well as any such individuals from its affiliated Provincial Associations and member clubs (collectively referred to as the “**Affiliates**”), shall not be considered responsible for any death, personal injury, illness, damage, property damage, expense, loss of income or loss of any kind that I may suffer during, or as a result of my use of strapping in my boat while participating at the Competition.
4. I agree to forever release the Organization and its Affiliates from any and all liability for any and all claims, demands, actions, damages (including direct, indirect, special and/or consequential), losses, actions, judgments, and costs (including legal fees) (collectively, the “**Claims**”) which I may have now or in the future, that might arise out of, result from, or relate to my use of strapping in my boat while participating in the Competition, even though such Claims may have been caused by any manner whatsoever, including but not limited to, the negligence, gross negligence, negligent rescue, omissions, carelessness, breach of contract and/or breach of any statutory duty of care of the Organization or its Affiliates.
5. By signing this Waiver, I (or my parent or legal guardian, if I am under the age of 18) acknowledge that I have read and understand this Waiver, that I have been, by the present, made aware that I can seek legal advice regarding this Waiver, that I have executed this Waiver voluntarily, and that this Waiver is to be binding upon myself, my heirs, spouse, children, parents, guardians, next of kin, executors, administrators and legal or personal representatives.
