



ICF WORLD UNIVERSITY CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM CRITERIA SUPPLEMENT 2022

Final Selection Criteria Approved by the Sprint Racing Council – March 17, 2022

INTRODUCTION

1. General

This Selection Criteria Supplement is subject to and will be applied in accordance with the principles and procedures as outlined in the National Team Selection Procedures 2022 - Sprint Document found on the [CKC Website](#).

2. Performance Objectives

CKC's performance objective is that an athlete should demonstrate the ability/potential to make a Top 8 at the U23 World Championships and be progressing toward a podium performances at Senior World Championships and Olympic Games. This Selection Criteria Supplement shall be applied in a manner that takes the aforementioned performance objective into account.

3. Selection Overview

- 3.1 The 2022 ICF University World Championships will take place September 16-18, 2022 in Bydgoszcz, Poland.
- 3.2 In addition to the eligibility requirements specified in the National Team Selection Procedures 2022 – Sprint, Crews must meet the eligibility requirements to participate in the ICF University World Championships according to FISU regulations. - 3.3 Please note that this is a self-pay event.

3.4 The only 2022 competition that will be used to nominate the Team is National Team Trials #2 (NTT2), Montreal, Quebec, June 24-28.

** Notwithstanding the above, in the event that NTT2 is cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic and related public health restrictions, CKC will inform affected athletes as soon as reasonably possible if the event will be replaced for Team nomination purposes (and, if so, which event will replace it and when it will be held) or if the nomination process will proceed on the basis of the events that will be held (and, if so, how this may impact the nomination process outlined herein).

3.6 Crews will be nominated as follows:

2.6.1 Eligible Crews nominated to the U23 World Championship Team

2.6.2 Crews according to National Rank in each Discipline at the conclusion of NTT2 as follows:

2.6.2.1 Women's K1 500m Final 1 and Final 2 Combined Ranking 1st ranked eligible

Women's K1 500m Final 1 and Final 2 Combined Ranking 2nd ranked eligible

Women's K1 500m Final 1 and Final 2 Combined Ranking 3rd ranked eligible

Women's K1 500m Final 1 and Final 2 Combined Ranking 4th ranked eligible

2.6.2.2 Women's C1 200m 1st ranked eligible

Women's C1 200m 2nd ranked eligible

Women's C1 500m 1st ranked eligible

Women's C1 500m 2nd ranked eligible

2.6.2.4 Men's K1 1000m 1st ranked eligible

Men's K1 1000m 2nd ranked eligible

Men's K1 500m 1st ranked eligible

Men's K1 500m 2nd ranked eligible

2.6.2.5 Men's C1 1000m 1st ranked eligible

Men's C1 1000m 2nd ranked eligible

Men's C1 500m 1st ranked eligible

Men's C1 500m 2nd ranked eligible

2.6.4 Points will be applied to the position of finish with 1st place scoring 18 points, 2nd place 17 points, 3rd place 16 points, and so on.

2.6.5 Only results from the final at any trials will be used. Race-off results related to team selections will not be considered;

2.6.6 The number of Crews selected in each discipline will be dependent on:

2.6.6.1 The event schedule

2.6.6.2 Must rank in the top 16 on the National Discipline Ranking List.
