



OLYMPIC HOPES CRITERIA SUPPLEMENT 2022

Final Selection Criteria Approved by the Sprint Racing Council – March 17, 2022

1. General

- 1.1 This Selection Criteria Supplement is subject to and will be applied in accordance with the principles and procedures as outlined in the National Team Selection Procedures 2022 - Sprint Document found on the [CKC Website](#).

All athletes selected to the Olympic Hopes Team must pay a team fee ahead of participation in this event. An estimate of this team fee will be communicated at the time of registration for NTT2.

2. Performance Objectives

2.1 This 2022 Olympic Hopes Team Criteria Supplement shall be applied in accordance with CKC's performance objective, which is to identify Crews who have demonstrated the ability/potential to make a Top 8 finish in an Olympic event at the International Competition for which they are being considered.

2.2 The Olympic Hopes Regatta will take place in Bratislava, Slovakia from September 9-11, 2022.

3. Selection Overview

3.1 Nomination can occur through 3 Prioritized Pathways listed here and detailed below:

3.1.1 Priority 1 – NTT2 Ranking

3.1.2 Priority 2 – National Championship Ranking

3.3 Unless cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic and related public health restrictions, the only 2022 competitions that will be used in the selection of the Team are:

3.3.1 National Team Trials #2 (NTT2), Montreal, Quebec, June 24-28, 2022

3.3.2 National Championships, Shawinigan, Quebec, August 23-27, 2022

Notwithstanding the introductory language of Section 3.3, in the event that one of the competitions listed above is cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic and related public health restrictions, CKC will inform affected athletes as soon as reasonably possible if the event will be replaced for Team nomination purposes (and, if so, which event will replace it and when it will be held) or if the nomination process will proceed on the basis of the events that will be held (and, if so, how this may impact the nomination process outlined herein).

3.5 The Olympic Hopes Team nomination process will be completed on or before August 28, 2022.

3.6 Final entries at the Olympic Hopes Regatta are at the discretion of the Head Coach.

3.7 To assist athletes/crews and coaches, an overview of the selection process is provided below in Appendix C..

4 Priority 1: NTT2 Ranking

4.1 The highest ranked U17 athletes in the following U18 Events at NTT2 will be nominated to the Olympic Hopes Team:

U18 Women C1 200m

U18 Women C1 500m

U18 Women K1 500m Final 1

U18 Men C1 1000m

U18 Men C1 500m

U18 Men K1 1000m

U18 Men K1 500m

If a U16 athlete is ranked as the top U17 athlete they will count as the U17 athlete.

If the same athlete is the highest ranked U17 athlete in two of the events listed in this Section 4.1 from the same discipline at NTT2, the second ranked athlete in the same discipline in the event that is a 2024 Olympic event will be named to the Olympic Hopes Team.

4.1.1 Additionally the highest ranked U17 Women K1 crew not already selected from a combine ranking list of Final 1 and Final 2 will be nominated.

4.2 The highest ranked ranked U16 athletes in the following U18 Events at NTT2 will be nominated to the Olympic Hopes Team:

U18 Women C1 200m

U18 Women C1 500m

U18 Women K1 500m Final 1

U18 Men C1 1000m

U18 Men C1 500m

U18 Men K1 1000m

U18 Men K1 500m

If a U16 athlete is ranked as the top U17 athlete they will count as the U17 athlete, and the next ranked U16 athlete will be nominated in that event.

If the same athlete is the highest ranked U16 athlete in two of the events listed in this Section 4.2 from the same discipline at NTT2, the second ranked athlete in the same discipline in the event that is a 2024 Olympic event will be named to the Olympic Hopes Team.

4.2.1 Additionally the highest ranked U17 Women K1 crew not already selected from a combine ranking list of Final 1 and Final 2 will be nominated.

5 Priority 2: National Championship Ranking

5.1 A U17 discipline ranking list will be created using the points system outlined in Appendix B below, based on the combined results of the following U18 events for each discipline (B Finals may be required)

Women Canoe C1 200m and C1 500m

Men Canoe C1 1000m and C1 500m

Men Kayak K1 1000m and K1 500m.

5.1.1 For Women's Kayak the ranking from the U18 Women's K1 500m will be used,

5.2 The top ranked U17 athlete in each of the four disciplines will be nominated to the Olympic Hopes Team. Athletes nominated under Priority 1 (NTT2) will not be included in this ranking. If a

U16 athlete races in U18 events at nationals they will count as a U17 athlete for the purposes of Olympic Hopes selection.

- 5.3 A U16 discipline ranking list will be created using the points system outlined in Appendix B below based on the combined results of the following U16 events for each discipline at the National Championships (B Finals may be required)

Women Canoe C1 200m and C1 1000m

Men Canoe C1 200m and C1 1000m

Men Kayak K1 200m and K1 1000m

Women Kayak K1 200m and K1 1000m

- 5.4 The top ranked U16 athlete in each of the four disciplines will be nominated to the Olympic Hopes Team. Athletes nominated under Priority 1 (NTT2) will not be included in this ranking.
- 5.5 The next ranked Left or Right Sided Paddler in the Men Canoe 1000m and/or Women Canoe 200m may be added to the Olympic Hopes Team if they are deemed to be required for crew boat entries.

APPENDIX A

Performance Times

Any performance times to be compared against the A-Final Time (AFT) will be rounded to the 10th of a second

E.g. 3.49.46 becomes 3.49.5 or alternatively 38.74 becomes 38.7.
